 - Time on target 9:15am
 - Multiple passes over parade
- Parade Company float being prepped
 - Being painted B-17 OD green
 - Graphics prepped for printing
 - Bunting and flags purchased
- City Hall parking lot mapped out for ceremony
 - DPW making vinyl stickers for the front facing windows to contain all the names from the War Memorial, honoring the fallen until construction is finished
