NOTICE OF PUBLIC SANITARY SEWER LINING

Please be advised that a City of Royal Oak contractor will be televising and cleaning the public sanitary sewer in your neighborhood during the next several weeks. This work is being performed in preparation for new sewer lining work to improve the public sewer service to your residence and others in your neighborhood. You will be notified at least 24-hours in advance before performing any sewer cleaning work. Once the sewer cleaning is complete, you will receive another notice from the contractor (Insituform Technologies USA, LLC) stating the exact date the public sewer adjacent to your residence will be lined.

The entire sewer lining process will take about 12 hours and is tentatively scheduled to occur between 8 a.m. and 8 p.m. During this 12 hour period, we are asking residents to minimize the use (i.e., no clothes washing, dishwashing, or showers) or not use of your sewer system if possible. Failure to do so may cause sewer backups in your residence. During the lining and curing operation, your private sewer tap into the public sewer will be temporarily closed when the new liner is installed. Once the liner has cured, approximately 6 hours after installation, each private sewer lead will be opened to restore service to individual properties.

All work is to be performed internally within the sewer pipe and excavations should not be necessary. To perform the work, the contractor will be accessing manholes that are located in the public right-of-way and in easements adjacent to lot lines. All equipment placed in easements will be removed by the contractor prior to the end of the day. Temporary "No Parking" signs may be posted in advance along streets to allow the contractor to safely access manholes in the public right-of-way.

It is our intention to minimize any inconvenience associated with the work and we thank all residents in advance for your cooperation. The sewer cleaning and lining are presently scheduled to be performed between Sept. 12, 2016 and Dec. 10, 2016, and you will be notified of the exact date for sewer lining by the contractor.
