When the employee confronted the suspect he pulled a large kitchen style knife from his shorts and held it at his side. The employee immediately backed away and attempted to use her cell phone to call for help. While she was calling, the suspect grabbed her phone, threw it to the floor, and fled the store. The suspect didn't say anything during the encounter and no one was injured.

After exiting the doors on the southeast side of the store, he walked to an unknown make/model dark colored pickup truck and drove towards Coolidge Highway.

He was described as a black male, approximately 40-years-old, with a medium build. He was wearing a white baseball hat with a black rim, white t-shirt, jean shorts and white shoes.
