Additional Incidents and Information

Suspect Arrested for Larceny from Auto

On September 25, 2020, at 5:04 a.m., Royal Oak Officers responded to a report a possible larceny suspect inside a vehicle in the 2400 block of N. Wilson. The caller later observed the male suspect leave the vehicle, enter his neighbor's vehicle, and then walk down the street. Royal Oak Officers quickly set up a perimeter and the suspect was apprehended. His girlfriend was located nearby waiting in his vehicle and was also arrested for an outstanding warrant.

The suspect was identified as Michael Gabriel Davis of Detroit. Davis had a warrant for his arrest for failing to appear on a larceny charge at the 19th District Court in Dearborn. His girlfriend was 28-year-old Detroit resident who also had a misdemeanor warrant for her arrest for Fraud out of the 16th District Court.

Royal Oak Police have been investigating numerous larcenies from automobiles in the last month. During further investigation, it was discovered Davis was associated with three other larcenies from vehicles.

On Sunday, September 27, 2020, Michael Gabriel Davis was arraigned before Magistrate Nancy Orletski of the 44th District Court. Davis is charged with one (1) count of Larceny from Auto, a felony which carries a penalty of up to 5 years in prison and one (3) counts of Breaking and Entering Auto less than \$200.00, a misdemeanor which carries a penalty of up to 93 days imprisonment.

Davis has a lengthy criminal history with convictions of Larceny from a Motor Vehicle, Obstructing a Police Officer, Felony Larceny from a Motor Vehicle, Breaking and Entering a Motor Vehicle, and Felony First Degree Home Invasion.

Davis is currently on parole for First Degree Home Invasion out of Wayne/Detroit Metro District Parole Office.

Davis's bond was set at \$10,000 cash 10%. His next scheduled court appearance is set for October 9, 2020 at 9:00 a.m. before Judge Derek Meinecke of the 44th District Court.
