**Suspect Arrested for Threatening to Shoot People at Cosmetology School**

On Tuesday, October 20, 2020, at approximately 9:55 a.m., officers were dispatched David Pressley School of Cosmetology located at 1127 S. Washington for a threat complaint.

Officers spoke with the director of the school who stated a student was expelled earlier in the day for bad behavior. The director, as well as several other students, received group texts regarding threats to "shoot up" the school. One of the group texts including a picture of a gun.

The 24-year-old suspect then called the business several times and made more threats. The threats were treated as credible by the staff and they cancelled classes for the next couple of days out of fear.


The Criminal Investigations Division investigated the incident and located the suspect at a relative's house in Detroit. She was arrested for the threats and she had a warrant for her arrest for Felony ID Theft out of 36<sup>th</sup> District Court.

On Thursday, October 22, 2020, Ariel Simontee Moore of Detroit was arraigned before the Honorable Magistrate Chisolm of the 44<sup>th</sup> District Court. Moore was charged with one (1) count of False Report or Threat of Terrorism, a felony which carries a penalty of 20 years in prison and fines up to \$20,000.00.

Moore's next court appearance is scheduled for October 30, 2020 at 9:16 a.m. before the Honorable Judge Meineke of the 44<sup>th</sup> District Court.

Moore's criminal history consisted of Felonious Assault and Felony Warrant for Felony ID Theft out of the 36<sup>th</sup> District Court.

Moore's bond was set at \$20,000, Cash/Surety 10%.
